Introduction • Explanation of the theme

Welcome to the National Church of God by Faith Ten Days of Consecrated Prayer 2017! Since implementing this vision in 2016, we have seen how prayer has come to have an impact on humanity in some very profound ways. Many of God's people have experience a life changing epiphany through prayer.

I believe that the Lord's vision for His church in 2017 is that we come together as a united force in praying for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit to ignite within us a passion for evangelizing, soul winning, church planting, community outreach, and financial resource solutions.

Vision is the bridge between the present and the future. Without it, we perish. God's vision helps us understand where we are with the respect to where we are going. The sons of Issachar are a great example of this kind of vision.

The book of Chronicles says that these men understood the times and had knowledge of what Israel should do. God has blessed our church leaders with this type of vision concerning the seasons of life.

Vision requires visionaries. Visionaries are people who have the mind, heart, and courage to trust God. As a church, we are to function as a body of believers. Vision requires us to move out of our comfort zone for worthy causes, and challenge others to do the same. God's vision for His church is of a great army, fully armed, well disciplined, clear as to its mission, and filled will zeal for battle. We are aware of the cost, but as the people of God, we are willing to take risks to achieve the vision that is of so much greater value.

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning, its shame, and set down on the right hand of the throne of God (Hebrew 12:2 NIV).

Leader's Guide • Developing your plan is key

During these ten days of Consecrated Prayer in 2017, we must start by preparing our bodies to become a living sanctuary, pure and holy for the Master's use. Our sanctuary is the foundation stones of our faith and hope. As we take on God's character, the Holy Spirit will direct us on how we should live on earth with a view of eternity and that we cannot do anything on our own power.

It is only because of Jesus Christ and His sacrifice that His righteousness is given to us. As we start this year off with fasting and praying, let us pray to the Holy Spirit for guidance on what we should pray for in a particular situation or in a person's life. Faithful is He that hath called you.

Every promise in the Word of God is for us. We must keep our minds braced in prayer and study God's word, that we may grasp these truths and move with the vision for Higher grounds in Christ Jesus.

We encourage you to remember to pray for seven people whom you would like to see draw closer to the Lord. They can be relatives, friends, coworkers, neighbors, or simply acquaintances.

Like the dew that brings refreshment to the earth, the church is intended to water the world with God's grace, in daily droplets of good works and words of truth and life that edify and nurture (Micah 5:7).

The role of the pastor is to guarantee success in these services. It is vital that the pastor selects a coordinator to organize and plan the entire 10 Day event. Each service should be carefully designed to last (but is not limited to) one hour. The suggested starting times are 7:00pm to 8:00pm or 7:30 pm to 8:30pm. Saturday and Sunday services are to be held at the discretion of the pastor.

The coordinator is to:

1. Review the Leaders' Guide for the 10 Days of Consecration Prayer.
2. Construct a formulated outline as a unified guide for the Prayer Leaders.
3. Choose ten consecrated Prayer Leaders; one for each day.
4. Submit the outline to the pastor for approval.
5. Provide training for the selected Prayer Leaders.
6. Advertise these services in your community.

The role of the prayer leader

is to make sure that each service is a moving worship experience.

The leader should encourage members to pray in the most comfortable position suited for them which may include standing, sitting or kneeling.

The goal is to be comfortable enough to make a connection with God.

Prayer leaders must adhere to the **FIVE (5) SECTIONS** outlined by the coordinator as a guide tool for conducting the prayer service.

1 Praise & Adoration

(Approximately 10 minutes)

Select an appropriate song that correlates with the daily focus prayer topic. You have the flexibility of choosing someone to sing if you desire. Please notify the singer before service begins.

2 Scripture

(Approximately 5 minutes)

The Leader or designee should read the assigned Consecrated Day scripture chosen for that particular day.

3 Quite Confession

(Approximately 5 minutes)

The Prayer Leader should encourage the members to silently confess their issues to God. Do not encourage open, personal confessions.

4 Supplication - Intercession:

(Approximately 35 minutes)

Since this is the most sacred part of the service, the Prayer Leader or designee should make sure that the prayer made is geared towards the Daily Focused requests for that particular day.

5 Thanksgiving

(Approximately 10 minutes)

This concluding section calls for singing, praising, and rejoicing in the Lord.

day 1 - Thursday 12th

• "Enter His Gates with Thanksgiving"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is, for His love, His wisdom, His holiness, etc.
- ⇒ Praise God that “in His presence is fullness of joy” (Ps. 16:11).
- ⇒ Praise God for those connected during prayer and the lessons they will learn from the Word of God.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name” (Psalms. 100: 4).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show what sins we need to confess in our heart. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for not always having a thankful heart.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ The recent presidential election cycle has given rise to acts of hatred and social unrest in the streets of America. Pray for God’s intervention to restore peace and order in our nation.
- ⇒ Pray that God will give thankful spirits.
- ⇒ Pray that we learn to rejoice in trials through the Holy Spirit that abides in your heart daily.
- ⇒ Pray that our words will be words of praise and thankfulness that will point people to Jesus.
- ⇒ Ask God to help us reflect Him in our speech.
- ⇒ Pray that we will lift up Christ and Him crucified and coming again—for He is our Saviour and Lord, who has given us His last warning message of love and redemption to proclaim to the world.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray for all church members to feel a burden for souls as we follow in Christ's steps and interact with those who need a personal relationship with the Lord.
- ⇒ Pray for a spiritual revival for the Church of God by Faith 2nd Century, including people attending public colleges and universities worldwide. Pray that they will become vibrant ambassadors and missionaries for Christ.
- ⇒ Pray for the Church of God by Faith outreach as it coordinates church planting projects around the world and seeks the funds needed to send Global Mission pioneers into uninterred areas.
- ⇒ Pray for people who live in the world's large cities and are surrounded by so many things that distract them from Jesus. Pray that they would be able to hear the whisper of the Holy Spirit amid their surroundings.
- ⇒ Pray for God to raise up medical missionaries to serve globally.
- ⇒ Pray for God to raise up 2nd Century individuals to actively participate in planting churches throughout the United States of America and abroad.
- ⇒ Pray for Church of God by Faith ministers as they mobilize chaplains and interested members to minister to those in prison.
- ⇒ Pray for financial provisions to support missions.

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God for the joy experienced while in His presence.
- ⇒ Thank God for the privilege of being a witness through your words of praise and thankfulness.
- ⇒ Thank God for the amazing things He is going to do these ten days.

day 2 - Friday 13th

• "The Altar of Burnt Offering"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer by praising God for who He is.
- ⇒ Praise God for the gift of salvation.
- ⇒ Thank God for the sacrifice of Jesus.
- ⇒ Praise God for the life of Jesus that showed us how to sacrifice self and surrender our will to God.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service" (Rom. 12:1).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show you which sins you need to confess openly and which you need to confess privately. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for times when you were afraid to sacrifice that which causes you to stumble.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Just as Titus partnered with Paul's ministry, ask God to send committed partners to financially and prayerfully support the By Faith Partner (BFP) initiative.
- ⇒ Pray that just as the altar of burnt offering was anointed with the holy oil (Ex. 40:10), your life will be anointed with the Holy Ghost, so that whatever you offer and sacrifice to the Lord will be acceptable to God.
- ⇒ Ask God to take away anything that hinders you from surrendering your time, money, strength, abilities, fears, hopes, and will. Tell Him you want to belong wholly to Christ.
- ⇒ Does anything in your heart hinder you from giving yourself wholly to Him? Tell Him about it. Ask Him to make you willing to surrender anything.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray for your family members and friends who are afraid to place their whole lives on the altar of sacrifice. Ask God to make them willing to give Him everything.
- ⇒ Pray that your local pastor and church leaders at different levels will make an unreserved surrender to God and His service.
- ⇒ Pray that we spend more time on eternal values through Bible study and prayer. Pray for God's will to be done rather than our own, and ask that the Holy Spirit will keep us from worldly influences and trends that threaten our daily spiritual experience.
- ⇒ Pray that the young people of our church will not be afraid to crucify self.
- ⇒ Pray for all peoples of non-Christian backgrounds. Pray that God's people will learn how to build whatever bridges are necessary to reach them.
- ⇒ Ask God for godly, teachable, and humble church leaders who will portray Christ-centered leadership in the church's mission to proclaim the three angels' messages.

- ⇒ And pray that Christ's righteousness will be at the core of these messages.
- ⇒ Pray that we will have an influence in large cities around the world. Pray that these centers make a real difference in lives as people discover God's truth through Christian service.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will see their need and open their hearts for the Holy Spirit.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.

Thanksgiving *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God that He will answer according to His will and in His time.
- ⇒ Thank God that He is willing to take your sinful heart and make it pure and holy.
- ⇒ Thank God that Jesus was willing to live and die, not for Himself but for the One who sent Him.
- ⇒ Thank God for revealing Himself in a special way in your life during these ten days of prayer.

day 3 - Saturday 14th • "The Laver"

Praise & Adoration (Approx. 10 minutes)

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is (His character).
- ⇒ Praise God that He wants to wash away all your sins.
- ⇒ Praise God that He is calling you to live a pure and holy life.

Scripture (Approx. 5 minutes)

- ⇒ "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water" (Heb. 10:22).

Quiet Confession (Approx.: 5 minutes)

- ⇒ Ask God to show you if there are any sins you need to confess privately. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God to forgive you for times when your words and acts did not demonstrate purity of character.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray that just as the laver was anointed with the holy oil the Holy Spirit will cleanse and purify your heart (Ex. 40:11).
- ⇒ Is there any area in your life in which you do not reflect the cleanliness and purity that Christ desires for you? Surrender it to God.
- ⇒ Is your home a clean and pure place? Ask God to help you make your home a place where the angels love to dwell.
- ⇒ Do you sometimes have a hard time keeping your thoughts positive and pure? Surrender your thoughts to God and ask Him to sanctify them.
- ⇒ Pray that the children and young people in your church will understand the importance of cleanliness and purity in the home and also in their conversations and thoughts.
- ⇒ Do you know anyone who struggles in the area of inward and outward cleanliness and purity? Lift them up in prayer.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray that we will point people to Christ and His righteousness as the only way to eternal life.
- ⇒ Pray for increased emphasis on “Revival and Reformation” throughout the world.
- ⇒ Pray for this revival for yourself, your family, your church, and your community. Pray also for engagement in worldwide prayer activities, as we plead together for the latter rain of the Holy Spirit and the fulfilment of Joel 2, Hosea 6, and Acts 2.
- ⇒ Ask God to protect our young people and each of us from worldly influences as we focus on the Bible and selfless service to others.
- ⇒ Pray for the increasing number of secular people in the world who have no interest in religion of any kind. Pray that the Holy Spirit will cut through the walls they have built up in their hearts.
- ⇒ Gross darkness and uncertainty are prevalent but where sin abounds, grace does much more abound. Intercede for God’s grace and light to shine through as America embarks on a new presidency.
- ⇒ Pray for the Muslim nations and groups of the world who remain resistant to Jesus Christ. Pray that they hear and respond to the gospel.
- ⇒ Pray for God to raise up urban missionaries to plant churches for the 806 people groups within the 20 countries of Inter-European Division.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will allow God to put a desire for purity in their hearts.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God that the “the inward man is being renewed day by day” (2 Cor. 4:16).
- ⇒ Thank God that He is willing to come and live in your heart.
- ⇒ Thank God that He has sent angels out to answer the prayers you have prayed this week.

day 4 - Sunday 15th

• "The Table of Showbread"

Praise & Adoration (Approx. 10 minutes)

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is.
- ⇒ Praise God that Jesus is the Bread of Life.
- ⇒ Praise God that He is inviting you to eat from this Bread of Life.

Scripture (Approx. 5 minutes)

- ⇒ "And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst" (John 6:35).

Quiet Confession (Approx.: 5 minutes)

- ⇒ Ask God to show you if you're holding back from surrendering anything to Him. Confess this privately to Him. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God to forgive you for times when you did not choose to eat of the Bread of Life.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession
(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Ask the Lord that just as the table of showbread was anointed with oil the Holy Spirit will direct and teach you in your Bible study (Ex. 40:9).
- ⇒ Pray that God will help you to eat of the Bread of Life daily and spend daily time in the Word.
- ⇒ Pray that church leaders (your local pastor, district elder and national leaders) will spend time in God's Word daily.
- ⇒ Pray that God will teach you how to share the Bread of Life with others.
- ⇒ Pray for a renewed focus on studying the books of Daniel and Revelation, with a particular emphasis on the blessings of the sanctuary service.
- ⇒ Pray for stronger participation in personal daily reading and following the Bible through "Believe His Prophets," which emphasizes the study of the Bible and the Spirit of Prophecy.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Do you have friends or acquaintances who are not feeding upon the Bread of Life but upon the temporary things that this world offers? Pray for them. Ask God how you can help them understand the importance of taking time to eat the heavenly bread.
- ⇒ Pray for the Asian people groups that include the Buddhists and Hindus, many of whom have never even heard of Jesus or what He has done. Pray that God will give us special wisdom for knowing how to reach their hearts.
- ⇒ Pray for God to raise up an army of workers to plant churches all over the country.
- ⇒ Pray for God to raise up ByFaith missionaries who are willing to work in America and abroad.
- ⇒ Pray for the people around the world where there is so little Christian influence. Pray that God will open the hearts of the people to receive the good news of Jesus.

- ⇒ Pray for an increased appreciation of the Spirit of Prophecy writings as being applicable today. Pray that church leaders and members read the instructions, counsel, and encouragement on a regular basis.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will understand the need to read God's Word and feed on the Bread of Life.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God for the ways Jesus set us an example of how to spend time daily in communion with the Father.
- ⇒ Thank God in advance for how He is going to work and answer your prayers.
- ⇒ Thank God that, when we eat the Bread of Life, we can be transformed into His character

day 5 - Monday 16th

• "The Lampstand"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is (His character).
- ⇒ Praise God that He is calling us to be His witnesses.
- ⇒ Praise God that He is a light unto our path.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ "Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, that I am God" (Isa. 43:12).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show you the sins you need to confess openly and the ones you need to confess privately. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Have there been times when you were not a good witness for God? Ask Him for forgiveness.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray that just as the lampstand (Ex. 40:9) was anointed with oil, you will be filled with the Holy Spirit and become a light and witness for the Lord.
- ⇒ Pray that God will help you reveal His character to those around you.
- ⇒ Ask God for a humble heart so you can see the areas of life in which you do not exert a good influence on others.
- ⇒ Do you have any areas in your life in which you need to grow in order to reflect Christ? Give God permission to work in those areas.
- ⇒ Ask God to fill you with His love so that His love can flow from you to others.
- ⇒ Pray for the involvement of every church member around the world in proclamation of the loud cry. Pray also that, as we submit to the Holy Spirit, He will make us one in Him.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray for increased spiritual and evangelistic understanding by every church administrator around the world as they lift up Christ and the unique mission and message of the Church of God by Faith. Ask God to help His people never to lose the prophetic identity of who we are.
- ⇒ Pray for a strong focus on small-group outreach, giving all members the opportunity to participate in personal witnessing about Jesus and His beautiful character. Pray that each of our fundamental beliefs and doctrines is proclaimed with Jesus at the core.
- ⇒ Pray earnestly that ByFaith families may reveal God's love in the home and community by showing how Christ can bring harmony into homes and remove abuse and stress through the sanctifying power of His righteousness. Pray that we may point others to the blessed opportunity of joining God's eternal family in heaven.
- ⇒ Pray for the thousands of Global Mission pioneers who are planting churches, many of them in dangerous situations. Pray for their safety, for wisdom, and for success.
- ⇒ Pray for God to prepare volunteers to serve this church like never before.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will see Christ in you and will want to have Him in their hearts too.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have (Prov. 3:5, 6).

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God that He is willing to work on you and change you.
- ⇒ Thank God that He can make you a light that shines into darkness.
- ⇒ Thank God that He is answering the prayers you prayed according to His will.

day 6 - Tuesday 17th

• "The Altar of Incense"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is (His character).
- ⇒ Praise God for Jesus who showed us that we need to intercede for others.
- ⇒ Praise God that He gave us the great privilege of interceding.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ "I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men" (1 Tim. 2:1).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show you what sins you need to confess in your heart. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times you failed to pray for others.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Just as the altar of incense was anointed with oil (Ex. 40:9), pray that your prayers will be inspired and guided by the Holy Ghost.
- ⇒ Lift up in prayer anyone for whom God has laid a burden on your heart.
- ⇒ Ask God to help you love anyone in your life that you have a hard time accepting.
- ⇒ Pray for every church to be used by the Holy Spirit in a greater emphasis toward outreach and evangelism.
- ⇒ Pray for those who are in a backslidden condition that they may return to the Lord.
- ⇒ Pray for those who are discouraged and burdened.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Intercede for believers who live in global regions where they are daily persecuted for Christ's name sake. Ask God to give them power to endure hardness as a good soldier.
 - ⇒ Pray for unity of the Spirit in every church and that all members of the Body of Christ may be one as the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost are one.
 - ⇒ Intercede for the saints that we all come in the unity of the faith and knowledge of the Son of God unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.
 - ⇒ Intercede for those who have given themselves to preaching the Word of God.
 - ⇒ Pray for your church leaders including pastors, elders and ministers, district elders, ruling elders, our bishop, and all leaders within the five-fold ministry.
 - ⇒ Ask God to perfect the saints in His love.
- ⇒ Ask God to raise up intercessors to make up the hedge and stand in the gap sending up prayers for our nation from the altar without ceasing day and night.
 - ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will see their need for God and open their hearts to Him.
 - ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God for his abundant, unconditional love that is extended to all including those who don't know Him.
- ⇒ Thank God that the Holy Spirit makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered (Romans 8:26).
- ⇒ Thank God that Christ intercedes for us from His heavenly seat at the right hand of God (Romans 8:34).

day 7 - Wednesday 18th

• "The Ark: Aaron's Rod"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is (His character).
- ⇒ Praise God that He has called us to be vessels unto honor to bear fruit.
- ⇒ Praise God that we can bear fruit that will remain when we abide in Christ.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ "Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain" (John 15:16).
- ⇒ Ask God to help you grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show you what sins you need to confess in your heart and what sins you need to confess to one another that you may be healed. Claim His victory over those sins.

- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you did not bear fruit.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for trying to bear fruit in your own power.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray that just as Aaron's rod budded and bore fruit (Num. 17:8), others may be blessed by the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22, 23) in your life.
- ⇒ Pray that God will teach you how to abide in Christ (John 15:4).
- ⇒ Without Christ we can do nothing. Ask God to help you live a Christ-centered life so you can bring forth much fruit.
- ⇒ Pray for guidance and revelation from the Spirit on how to strategically set up church planting teams to effectively jumpstart new missions.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray for the zeal to further reach out as a church in foreign fields to spread the Gospel in neighboring countries.
- ⇒ Intercede for God to equip and perfect the saints through seasoned Bible teachers called to instruct and disciple new converts in the Word of God line upon line and precept upon precept.
- ⇒ Ask God to help you stay connected to Him that you may reflect Him to those around you.
- ⇒ Pray that God will teach you to rely upon His strength. Ask God to cause an influx of growth in our Youth Department stirring up the gifts of God in them with a sincere unfeigned faith to do greater works.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will see their need to abide in Christ and bear more fruit.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.
- ⇒ Pray that the saints faithfully bring their tithes and offerings into the storehouse and that God would open the windows of heaven and pour us out abundant blessings to fund the desired growth and expansion initiatives for our church.
- ⇒ Pray for God to send forth Evangelists to bring in the harvest establishing new missions in the western region of the United States.
- ⇒ Intercede for God to give us young pastors after His own heart to train and care for the flock at the newly established missions in the western region of the United States.

Thanksgiving *(Approx.10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God for the privilege of abiding in Him. Through Him alone, we will bud and bring forth fruit.
- ⇒ Thank God that Christ is your strength.
- ⇒ Thank God for laying down His life for us that through His love, we can be a blessing to others.

day 8 - Thursday 19th

• "The Manna"

Praise & Adoration *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for who He is (His character).
- ⇒ Praise God that Jesus is the Manna that came down from heaven.
- ⇒ Praise God that we can feed upon His Word.

Scripture *(Approx. 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ "I am the living bread that came down from heaven: if any man eats of this bread, he shall live forever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world" (John 6:51).

Quiet Confession *(Approx.: 5 minutes)*

- ⇒ Ask God to show you what sins you need to confess in your heart. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you did not feed on the Word.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you chose to satisfy your hunger with temporal things.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray for "peace in transition." We pray that the peace of God which passes all understanding will keep our heart and minds through Christ Jesus as we experience breakdowns of order in the political systems (Philippians 4:7 KJV). Keep us in perfect peace as we keep our minds stayed on you (Isaiah 26:3 KJV).
- ⇒ Pray that just as the Israelites gathered manna early in the morning, we will be willing and obedient to seek God early for a fresh revelation of His Word.
- ⇒ Ask the Holy Spirit to make your character like Christ's.
- ⇒ Intercede for the safety, wisdom and success of those sent on the mission field to plant new churches.
- ⇒ Pray that believers will remain steadfast, unmovable always abounding in the work of the Lord. Pray for our willingness to be obedient in all things so the power of God can be mightily demonstrated through us.

Praise & Adoration (Approx. 10 minutes)

- ⇒ Begin your prayer time by praising God for giving us wondrous things out of His law.
- ⇒ Praise God that His law is a law of love.
- ⇒ Praise God that He writes His law in our hearts.

Scripture (Approx. 5 minutes)

- ⇒ "Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law" (Psalm 119:18).

Quiet Confession (Approx.: 5 minutes)

- ⇒ Ask God to show you what sins you need to confess in your heart. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you willingly chose to go against His law.
- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray for the new administration. We pray for "able men" who fear God, men of truth who hate dishonest gain. These will lead the people with diligence. Turn the heart of President Donald Trump and those who will be chosen to serve in administrative positions. Exodus 18:21. The heart of the king is in the hand of the Lord. Lord turn the hearts of the political leaders whithersoever you will (Proverbs 21:1 KJV).
- ⇒ Ask the Holy Spirit to continually write His law in your mind and heart.
- ⇒ The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart. Ask God to help you live a life full of Christ's joy.
- ⇒ Pray that God will give you love in your heart for Him and for those around you.
- ⇒ By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. (John 13:35). Pray that we will be reflections of God's love.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Pray for each local church as they seek God's plan to minister to their communities through Bible Study and personal witnessing.
- ⇒ Ask God to send out Christian groups to share the Gospel bringing relief and necessary resources to those suffering in impoverished nations around the world.
- ⇒ Pray for the peace of Jerusalem.
- ⇒ Ask God to help us to visit orphans, widows, and the sick and shut-in.
- ⇒ Pray that we will consistently engage in alms-giving to the poor.
- ⇒ Ask God to help you deny self for the truth's sake so that you can make a holy impression on the world.
- ⇒ Pray for favor and adequate finances to complete the Ocala Temple renovation project.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will understand that God's law is a law of love and if we love God, we will keep His commandments.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.
- ⇒ Pray that our church will use every appropriate social media format to share God's message in a practical, creative, and fresh way to this generation.
- ⇒ Petition God to raise up prayer warriors to intercede for an outpouring of the Holy Ghost and the unity of the Spirit among the saints.

Quiet Confession (Approx.: 5 minutes)

- ⇒ Ask God to show you what sins you need to confess in your heart. Claim His victory over those sins.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you trusted in your own power.
- ⇒ Ask God for forgiveness for the times when you had a self-righteous spirit.

Supplication and Intercession

(Approx. 35 minutes)

- ⇒ Pray for America in times of transition. The Lord holds our hands. It is He who said, “fear not.” He is the one who helps us. Our Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 41:13-14 ESV - Lord go before us and make the crooked places straight (Isaiah 45:2 ISV).
- ⇒ Pray for someone who needs Christ’s robe of righteousness.
- ⇒ Ask the Lord to give you a desire to overcome sin and imitate the character of Jesus in your life.
- ⇒ Pray that the Holy Spirit will teach you how to accept Christ’s righteousness and live in it.
- ⇒ Petition God for leaders that hunger and thirst after righteousness so they may be filled with the wisdom and knowledge of God.
- ⇒ Pray for increased commitment from church members to attend weekly services and exercise their gifts to build and edify the Body at their local church.

Supplication and Intercession *(continued)*

- ⇒ Ask God to remove all schisms and divisions in His church.
- ⇒ Ask God to help each of us individually represent Christ and the garments of His righteousness in our daily lives, in our lifestyles, and in our dress.
- ⇒ Ask God for clean hands and a pure heart and the grace to remain unspotted from the world.
- ⇒ Righteousness exalts a nation. Pray for righteous leadership in our government.
- ⇒ Pray that the seven (or more) people on your list will see their need for Christ's righteousness.
- ⇒ Pray for any personal needs you have.
- ⇒ Ask the Holy Spirit to help us to present our bodies a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable unto God.

- ⇒ Pray that church leaders and members live upright and rapture ready knowing that we are in the last days and Jesus is soon to come.
- ⇒ Pray that God would empower us by His Spirit to be effective witnesses in our communities.
- ⇒ The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life and he that winneth souls is wise. Pray that God gives us His wisdom to win souls (Proverbs 11:30).

Thanksgiving *(Approx. 10 minutes)*

- ⇒ Thank God that He forgives you according to 1 John 1:9.
- ⇒ Thank God that he is working in the lives of your family, friends, and neighbors.
- ⇒ Thank God that He will perfect that which concerns us and we shall come forth as pure gold.
- ⇒ Thank God that His Word is quick and powerful sharper than any two-edged sword piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit. (Hebrews 4:12)

last day-Sunday 22nd

• Celebration Sunday

Witness and Servant

This final service should be a time of great rejoicing in all that God has done for you and your church during the Ten Days of Prayer. Design your day to celebrate God's goodness and mighty power. Consider how you have experienced the outpouring of the Holy Spirit during the past ten days. This service is an opportunity to rejoice in what He has done, is doing, and will do.

Theme Text: Isaiah 43:10

"Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me."

The needs of each congregation are unique, so please work with local leaders to develop a specific plan for your church.

Suggested Activities to include in your final consecration service:

- ⇒ **Biblical Teaching on Isaiah 43:10:** This could be a sermon or homily, or the passage could be used as a basis for weaving together stories of how God has worked during the Ten Days of Prayer.

- ⇒ **Testimonies:** Include ample time for testimonies of answered prayer. Those who have participated in the Ten Days of Prayer should have many stories they can share with the congregation, but encourage them to be brief so that everyone can participate. Others may also have stories. It might be good to have some testimonies pre-planned, in addition to having an open sharing time.

- ⇒ **Prayer Time:** Invite the whole congregation to join in a time of united prayer. You could lead the congregation through an interactive prayer similar to what you have used throughout the week. You can pray over a specific passage together. This could be done with people in small groups or with everyone praying together. Another option would be to have several different kinds of prayer throughout the service—praying the Scriptures, small-group, individual, congregational, silent, and so on.

⇒ **Singing:** This is a day to rejoice in all God has done, and music is a great way to celebrate. If there is a song that has become a theme song for your group, make sure to sing that song with the whole congregation.

⇒ **Future Plans:** If God has led you toward a special outreach or ministry through the Ten Days of Prayer, let your church family know about your plans and invite them to join in.

⇒ **Children/Youth:** A children's story about prayer would certainly be appropriate. Also, if you have had any children or youth involved with the regular prayer meetings, have them share their testimonies and/or lead out in a prayer time.

⇒ **Flexibility:** Make sure to be flexible in your plans so that you can follow the Holy Spirit's leading throughout the service.
